Minute Breakers at Nuneaton



A sensational performance at the Nuneaton Winter gala saw Leamington swimmer Finn Linton slash his 100m freestyle pb by five seconds. Recording 56.94 in the heat to go under the minute for the first time. The fourteen year old kept the pressure on in the final, nudging his time down to 56.56 for an easy gold and a place in the Midland Championships. Continuing to impress, Finn added three further gold medals in the 100 and 200 back and the 400m IM, winning with an eight second lead. Finishing with silver in the 400m free. Another great 100 free from Hannah Greenshield,17, also

going under one minute for the first time securing silver in 59.89. In the 100m fly Hannah had to settle for silver missing gold by just a few tenths.

Abby Jolley,10, maximised her chances being top of the age group winning a string of gold medals in the 100 and 200m back and 200m breaststroke along with third place in the 200m freestyle.

Fifteen year old Jessica Nash's strong performance in the 200m backstroke secured first place with a two second lead from team mate Hannah Pickett,16 in silver. Teigan Parker,13, produced bronze in the 100m breaststroke while Amy Pettigrew's patience paid off, the fifteen year old waited until the very end of the gala taking gold in the 400m medley qualifying for the Midlands Championships along with Sarah Smith in the 100m fly.
