

## Sensational Spring Meet



Leamington swimmers Teigan Parker and Kieran Curran both netted triple gold at Nuneaton's Spring Open meet. Parker swept the board in all three breaststroke events dropping a huge 4 seconds off her 100m time to 1.22.34, also gaining a further three Midland Qualifying times (MQT) in the 100, 200m back and 200m breaststroke bringing her total to a fantastic seven. Whilst Curran powered to success in the sprints 50m fly, 50m back and producing a flying 28.48 in the 50m final, later adding silver in the 50m breast. Kieran finished a great weekend of racing slashing his pb to shreds in the 100m and 200m backstroke events securing MQT in both. Warwickshire breaststroke Champion, Ellen Stone took gold in the 200m event.

Jess Nash,15, was rewarded with silver in the 200m back and a flurry of third places were clocked up by Abby Jolley,10, in the 50m fly, Jack Dennis,14, in the 50m back, Harry Manship,13, in the 50m breast along with a scorching time of 27.63 in the 50m free and Sarah Smith,16, gaining her first MQT in the 50m back. A total of 87 pb were set over the weekend.
